The Space Coast Climate Change Initiative (SCCCI) was established in 2007 with a goal of facilitating *local* government implementation of plans, policies, and/or programs to address global climate change. As an initial objective, the SCCCI seeks to promote sound coastal and ocean policies that address *rising sea level*, now projected to rise as much as 2 meters by 2100 (*Science* 5 September 2008).

There is no longer any serious doubt that global climate change is occurring. The uncertainties and debates now center on the severity of the impacts, how rapidly they could unfold, and what actions must be taken to mitigate and adapt to these changes.

On November 19, 2009, Dr. Randall W. Parkinson will discuss the science of climate change and associated rising sea level, the inadequacy of existing coastal response options, and the rationale for implementing a new style of planning and management to better protect our natural resources and reduce risks to human life.
